LAMDA and Half Term



I think that our fabulous children at WPAC are ready for a new challenge and so after much research and organising I have arranged for us to take our LAMDA exams. In class nothing will change, we will still have all our fun and games like usual but this time as well as working towards a performance to show everyone at the end of term, we will also be working on the performance to show the LAMDA examiner. The exam itself has to take place at an exam centre and our closest one is in Oakham. The exam will take about 30 minutes and will be on a Wednesday evening after school towards the end of the summer term. There will be a fee to be entered in to the exam and so it is not mandatory, but I really feel it would be great for all the children to help boost their confidence and give them a recognised accreditation. We think the fee will be about £20 but we are waiting to have this and the exact date confirmed by the Exam Centre. If you have any questions please ask me, I'm always happy to chat through things.

We are also running a half term workshop based on the hit film ENCANTO at the Studios over half term. It's open to any school age children and takes place over 3 days, culminating in a performance for friends and family. The dates are Wed 16th-Fri 18th Feb 10am-3pm daily and costs £90.
